Ages as of September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007

- Elementary Instructional League for ages 9-12
- Elementary Competitive for ages 9-12 (cannot be in 7th grade)
- Junior High for ages 12-14
- Junior Varsity and Varsity ages 15-18

A fee of \$30.00 per player must be paid at the time of registration, and  
a gym fee will be collected at the first practice.

**There will be a late fee of \$10.00 per player after September 1<sup>st</sup> and no Jr.-Sr.  
High registrations accepted after September 15<sup>th</sup>.**

before August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2007.

**Both parents** and **players** must attend to sign the paper work and mandatory  
volunteer list.
