

CHEF ARROWS BASKETBALL
2009-2010 Information and Instructions
ELEMENTARY COMPETITIVE TEAMS
(Boys & Girls Ages 9, 10, 11, and 12 as of September 1, 2008)

- PRACTICES: Practices begin in October and end in February.
- GAMES: Games will be played in January and February. If your son or daughter plays in the Elementary Christian School Conference (ECC) they will play approximately 10 games. The ECC does not allow seventh graders to play on our teams.
- COST:

Registration Fee	\$35.00 per player	(Due at registration)
Uniforms (Only if need one)	\$46.00 per player (est.)	(Due when uniforms are ordered-Nov. 15 th)
Gym Fees	\$25.00 (One time)	(Due first practice)

If a player already has a uniform there will be no cost for the uniform. A player may try to locate a used uniform to buy from a former player at a lower cost. If a team can locate a free gym, then the fee will be waived. A voluntary team fund-raiser can be used to offset gym fees and other costs.
- TEAMS: We will have one or two boy's teams and one or two girl's teams in the ECC League which is a competitive league and try-outs will be held; maximum of ten players per team.
- INSTRUCTIONAL LEAGUE: The Instructional League will not have try-outs and all registrants will get to play. The purpose of this League is to teach the basic basketball fundamentals to all participants, while introducing them to game conditions before playing competitively. It is very important for young players to learn to pass, shoot, dribble, rebound, and play defense properly. The cost per player will be less for this league vs. the ECC League. (See Elementary Instructional League page for more details.)
- REGISTRATION: The Registration Form and Parent and Player Code of Conduct Form must be completed and the \$35.00 fee must be paid at the time of returning the forms. Please put your e-mail address on the registration form. This is our #1 way to communicate with our players and their parents.
- PARENT VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP: Each player's parents must choose at least one area of responsibility for each of their child's teams or help in some other way. (Sign-up sheets are on registration table) We are a volunteer organization.
