Ages as of September 1st, 2009

- Elementary Instructional League for ages 9-12
- Elementary Competitive for ages 9-12 (no one can be in 7th grade)
- Junior High for ages 12-14
- Junior Varsity and Varsity ages 15-18 (Competitive)

A fee of \$35.00 per player must be paid at the time of registration, and
a gym fee will be collected at the first practice if needed. **There will be a late fee
of \$10.00 per player after September 1st and no Jr.-Sr. High registrations
accepted after September 15th, without special approval.**

If you are unable to attend the registration night, you can go to the CHEF's
website and down load the registration form and code of conduct and mail it in
before August 20, 2009. You will still need to sign the mandatory volunteer list.
Both parents and **players** must attend to sign the paper work and sign up for the
mandatory volunteer list.

Parents or parent must be **current members** of CHEF to register and participate
in the program.

CHEF membership renewal forms will be available at the Registration meeting.
An orientation meeting for those families who have never been CHEF members
will be held at 7:15 p.m. during the registration.

New member fees are \$24.00 per family. Renewal member fees are \$24.00 per
family if paid before September 15, and \$30.00 thereafter.
