2010-2010 Information and Instructions

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMS - VARSITY & JV

(Boys & Girls Ages 15, 16, 17, and 18 as of September 1, 2010)

- **PRACTICES:** Practices begin in September and end in March – three times a week in the Tulsa area, in the past the boys have practiced at Christview Christian Church. No practices on Wednesday evenings or Sundays.
- **GAMES:** Our first games are on October 29. We will play approximately 20-25 games per team. We play Christian & private schools in the Tulsa area and other homeschool teams and a few public schools. We play home and home games and some tournaments, may travel up to 2 hours for games. Our home gym is located at Broken Arrow North Intermediate High School which has a very nice court with lots of seating.
- **COST:**

Registration Fee	\$35.00 per player	(Due at registration)
Uniforms	\$100.00 (approx.)	(Due when uniforms are ordered-October 1 st)
Tournament Fees (3)	\$75.00-100.00	
Gym Fees	\$50.00-\$75.00	(Due September 15 th)

The Gym Fee depends on what we have to pay for gym rentals. If a team can locate a free gym, then the fee will be waived; in the past there has been no fee. A team fundraiser can be used to offset gym fees.
- **TEAMS:** We will have varsity teams for boys and girls plus a junior varsity (JV) team for boys 16 and under and for players that do not make the varsity team.
- **TRY-OUTS:** Varsity boys' try-outs will be held early in September at Christview Christian Church located at 2525 S. Garnett Road, Tulsa. All players must be registered for try-outs and practices. All teams will be limited to a maximum of 12 players.
- **REGISTRATION:** The Registration Form and Parent and Player Code of Conduct Form must be completed and the \$35.00 fee must be paid at the time of returning the forms. Please put your e-mail address on the registration form, this is our #1 way to communicate with our players and their parents.
- **PARENT VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP:** Each player's parents must choose at least **two** areas of responsibilities for each of their child's teams or help in some other way. All parents and players are responsible to work at our home games. We are an all volunteer organization.
