Parent's Code of Conduct:

I/we recognize that by allowing my child to play on this basketball team that I will be actively involved in the following ways:

1. I am currently home educating my child and he/she is passing. If my child does not maintain satisfactory academic and spiritual progress, I will notify the coach or the athletic director.
2. I will require my child to abide by the team rules and program guidelines (See Athlete's Commitment below).
3. I will remain under control during all games.
 - * I will not yell at the officials, my child, our players or coaches or the opponent players, parents or coaches.
4. I understand and agree to abide by the following appeal process:
 - * If I have a problem with someone, I will talk with that person seeking a resolution.
 - * If we are not able to resolve the situation then I will meet with the person and the athletic director.
 - * If no resolution is reached I will then meet with the person, the athletic director and the CHEF president.
 - * If there is still no resolution, it will then be at the discretion of the CHEF president or athletic director to bring the matter to the CHEF Board.
5. I recognize that CHEF Basketball is a competitive basketball program and that playing time is at the sole discretion of the coach based on his decision as to what will make the team the most successful. (Different rules apply to elementary teams.) Furthermore, I agree to support the coach in his decision whether I agree with him or not.
6. I understand that if I fail to abide by this commitment statement that the board has the authority to ask my family to leave the program and that we would not be entitled to any refund.
7. I understand that I must be a member of CHEF to participate in this program and agree to be current with my dues or join CHEF if not a member.

Athlete's Code of Conduct:

By joining this basketball team I am agreeing to uphold the following team rules:

1. I will demonstrate the character quality of attentiveness by listening to the instruction of my coaches.
2. I will demonstrate the character quality of faithfulness by attending all practices and games.
3. I will demonstrate the character quality of orderliness by following the dress code:
 - * No jewelry will be worn during practices and games.
 - * A clean-cut appearance is required for the season. No visible tattoos or body piercing. (Guys-No facial hair, no earrings, no radical hairstyles or colors, no ponytails or long hair) (Girls-No radical hairstyles or colors, no exposed midriiffs-test by raising arms over head.)
 - * Appropriate dress for all practices and games. (Game dress will be white T-shirt under official uniform accompanied by white socks) (Girls-No tank tops or gapping shirts, shorts to be mid-thigh or longer in length) (Guys-No beaters and must wear shirts) (See CHEF Athletics Handbook for further details)
 1. I will maintain a positive, teachable attitude no matter how much playing time I receive, how fair the officiating is or is not, or whether we win or lose.
 2. I will demonstrate the character quality of self-control by not participating in profane language, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, pornography, or immorality.
 3. I will keep my focus on basketball and avoid pairing off with a person of the opposite sex during all traveling trips and practices.
 4. I will demonstrate the character quality of discipline by following the rules that my team establishes.
- * CHEF's desire is to build unity among the players and not have any individual draw attention to himself by the way he/she looks or dresses. (Psalm 133:1)
